

Voluntary Tablet-Splitting Program



Many medications come in tablet form and can be split. If a medication you are taking is a lower dose and the higher dose is double what you are taking, you may be able to cut your costs by tablet-splitting. For example if you are on Crestor 20mg, your doctor could prescribe Crestor 40mg. Taking half of a 40mg tablet is the same as taking one 20mg tablet. This cuts your Crestor costs in half.

What to do:

1. Check the list below to see if one of your medications is available for tablet-splitting, then call your Pharmacy Advocate 748 4501 ext 6406. Some medications may require authorization to split the tablet.
2. Contact your doctor for a new prescription. Your Pharmacy Advocate may be able to help you with this process.
3. Obtain a FREE tablet splitter from your Pharmacy Advocate or purchase one – they are usually under \$5.
4. Cut your tablets, cut your costs.

Seroquel 25mg, 50mg, 100mg, 200mg

Singulair 5mg

Zyprexa 5mg, 7.5mg, 10mg
